HOME SCHOOL AGREEMENT

Home School Agreement

The school will...

- provide a wide range of activities beyond timetabled lessons.
- record all attendance and punctuality for morning and afternoon sessions each day.
- report attendance to parents at least termly.
- provide regular reports on student progress in writing and by consultation with parents.
- respond to contact made with the school, by the person best able to help.
- ensure that pupils follow the Hassenbrook Code for Responsible Behaviour and thereby provide an ordered working environment that will stimulate, encourage and support achievement.
- provide a safe and stimulating environment and encourage students to take responsibility for care of the school and respect for the people who work and study here..
- provide books, worksheets, paper and most technical and scientific equipment required.
- provide an equipment list to cover all other items needed for lessons.
- set varied and appropriate homework tasks for all students.
- provide after-school facilities to help students with their work: Homework Club.
- provide a homework planner where the timetable is recorded, and which the Registration Tutor checks and signs each week.
- encourage pupils to feel safe and valued and to do their best at all times.
- provide a balanced curriculum and strive to meet the individual needs of all pupils.
- provide a clear list of uniform requirements.
- provide a PE kit list, to cover requirements for all activities.

Home School Agreement The student will...

- consider participating in and supporting activities beyond normal lessons.
- aim for 100% attendance.
- bring a letter to explain any absence.
- be on the school site before the morning and afternoon sessions which begin at 8.30am and 2.05pm
- keep parents, teachers and other students informed of issues they need to know or matters with which the student needs some help.
- accompany their parents to Parents' Evening.
- follow the Code for Responsible Behaviour
- treat the school site, the buildings and equipment with respect at all times.
- keep Hassenbrook free from litter and graffiti
- arrive fully equipped for all lessons and activities involved in the school day.
- write all set tasks in the planner and complete them on time to the best of their ability.
- see teachers if the work set is posing problems.
- keep the planner up-to-date, showing it to teachers and parents when required.
- work hard to achieve results they feel proud of in all aspects of their learning.
- wear full school uniform to and from school and throughout the school day.
- bring the correct PE kit to each PE lesson, or a note from parents if too unwell to participate.

Home School Agreement Parents / Carers will...

- encourage their child to participate in and support the clubs, activities and events organised by the school.
- encourage 100% attendance.
- phone the school on the first day of absence.
- provide a letter on the day of their child's return to school.
- avoid any other absence, such as family holidays, whenever possible, as this would affect learning.
- inform the school of issues relating to their child's progress.
- work with the school to promote the close co-operation of their child, home, and school which brings success.
- attend Parents' Evenings and other discussions about their child's progress.
- work with the school to encourage their child to follow the Code for Responsible Behaviour.
- encourage their child to respect the environment both in and out of school.
- ensure that their child has all equipment necessary to do well both in and beyond lessons each day.
- provide facilities and support needed for their child to complete tasks successfully.
- check that homework is being recorded and completed and sign the planner each week.
- provide support and guidance to help their child achieve the best results possible and to enjoy their learning.
- ensure that their child leaves home in full school uniform each day and with PE kit when this is required.
- provide a note if their child is too unwell to participate in PE, confirmed by a doctor if a long-term problem.
